Mobility restricting DLCs must be signed and presented to the member by their unit commander. Presentation of all other DLCs can be delegated to others by the commander. First Sergeants and UDMs (not the member) will receive electronic copies as well. Supervisors will determine how to utilize the "DLC restricted" member. Only the HAWC can grant fitness exemptions.
